Initiation Level

Introducing the concept of chronic relational withdrawal and screening and assessment tools ADBB & M-ADBB scales

Choice of course depending the desired objectives and the people to be trained

2 online formats:

3-hour synchronous webinar for teams of more than 25 professionals (96 people maximum)

Expert Level 1

Referent to support teams and parents in their use of the M-ADBB scale

A 20-hour advanced training course for M-ADBB scale referents to support teams in their use of the M-ADBB scale and communicate on the notion of relational withdrawal.

OBJECTIVES: Master the pedagogical skills needed to communicate comfortably on the notion of relational withdrawal and its evaluation within health and mental health networks.

Choice of courses or 2 depending on desired objectives



Expert Level 1 (in 2026) Clinical training in the ADBB scale and video

feedback for the management of relational

withdrawal (1st-line intervention)

A 30-hour advanced training course for the management of relational withdrawal and the development of a therapeutic alliance with perinatal families

OBJECTIVES: To train healthcare professionals in the practical application of the ADBB scale and video feedback to identify and intervene early in cases of relational withdrawal in babies, while building a solid therapeutic alliance with families during the perinatal period.
